PAXLOVID is supplied in 3 dose packs: a standard dose pack, a dose pack for eligible patients with moderate renal impairment, and a dose pack for eligible patients with severe renal impairment

Moderate Renal Impairment Dose Pack in cube-shaped box

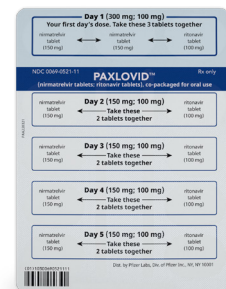


This represents 1 of 10 blister cards with each blister card holding 1 dose.

*PAXLOVID has not been approved, but has been authorized for emergency use by FDA under an EUA, for the treatment of mild-to-moderate COVID-19 in pediatric patients (12 years of age and older weighing at least 40 kg) who are at high risk for progression to severe COVID-19, including hospitalization or death.

The emergency use of PAXLOVID is only authorized for the duration of the declaration that circumstances exist justifying the authorization of the emergency use of drugs and biological products during the COVID-19 pandemic under Section 564(b)(1) of the Act, 21 U.S.C. § 360bbb-3(b)(1), unless the declaration is terminated or authorization revoked sooner.
