

### **Single-Use Thermal Shipping Container**

After use, the Single-Use Thermal Shipping Container should be disposed of at your facility.

To dispose of the Single-Use Thermal Shipping Container, please recycle the outer cardboard box and inner cardboard components. The remaining foam box and lid may be recycled or routed to landfill per local and state regulations.



### **Transfer, Storage and Disposal**

### **Time and Temperature Considerations**

- Handling the prefilled syringe carton between storage environments: immediately transfer prefilled syringe to refrigerated storage at 2°C to 8°C (35°F to 46°F).
- Do not open prefilled syringe cartons until there is a need to remove prefilled syringes for transfer, or use.
- Upon delivery:
  - Inspect the thermal shipping container to confirm that ordered or prefilled syringe cartons were received.
  - 2. Do not stack or place anything on top of the thermal shipping container.
  - 3. Do not freeze prefilled syringes

## Originating Temperature Environment From Thermal Shipping Container

2°C to 8°C

(35°F to 46°F)

### **Storage Instructions**

### Do NOT freeze contents

### **Prefilled Syringe Storage Information**

COMIRNATY glass prefilled syringes (NDC 0069-2377) may be stored at 2°C to 8°C (35°F to 46°F) until the expiration date printed on the carton and syringe labels.

### DO NOT FREEZE.

The total time out of refrigeration (at temperatures between 8°C and 25°C (46°F and 77°F)) must not exceed 12 hours.

### **Additional Storage Information**

Regardless of presentation during storage, minimize exposure to room light, and avoid exposure to direct sunlight and ultraviolet light.

Regardless of storage condition, the vaccine should not be used after the expiration date printed on the prefilled syringes and cartons. Prefilled syringes may be stored in the refrigerator according to the expiry date on the prefilled syringe and carton label and at room temperature [8°C to 25°C (46°F to 77°F)] for 12 hours prior to use.

### SAFE DISPOSAL OF VACCINE PREFILLED SYRINGES

- Discard prefilled syringes that have been at room temperature past 12 hours [8°C to 25°C (46°F to 77°F)].
- Discard prefilled syringes past expiration date.
- Discard prefilled syringes in a sharps container as medical waste to ensure they are permanently destroyed.
- Discard prefilled syringe cartons as medical waste so they cannot be reused.

All cartons of COMIRNATY prefilled received at 2°C to 8°C (35°F to 46°F), should be stored at 2°C to 8°C (35°F to 46°F).





### **Shipping and Handling Frequently Asked Questions**

Below are answers to some commonly asked questions about the shipping and handling of COVID-19 vaccines from BioNTech and Pfizer.

### Do customers have to return the thermal shipping containers?

### For Reusable Thermal Shippers:

- The reusable shipper should be returned.
- After use, the thermal shipping container, including all components inside must be returned to the supplier to help Pfizer fulfill its commitment to reusable resources.
- When the shipping container is ready to be returned, and all the components are inside, seal it with tape.


