GoQuick Instruction Mat

This set-up procedure will **only need to be done once with each new pen**. After that, you only need to follow 3 easy steps for daily use (see overleaf).

Initial set-up of your GOQUICK



Always wash and dry your hands before you start.

1. Attach needle, mix
Genotropin®, and remove air



- Attach the needle.
- Hold the pen with A facing you.
 Firmly twist the cartridge holder clockwise until B clicks into
- Gently tilt the pen from side to side. Do not shake it.
- Remove the outer needle cover. Leave inner needle cover on.
- Tap the cartridge holder gently.
- Firmly twist the cartridge holder clockwise until C clicks into the notch.

2. Attach needle guard (optional)



- Remove the **BLACK** cap from needle guard.
- Line up the BLACK logo with the pen logo and click into place.

3. Prime pen



- Remove the inner needle cover.
- Check that the lowest allowed dose is in the memory window.
- Turn the **GREY** dial in the direction of the arrows until it stops clicking.
- With the needle pointing up, push the **INJECTION BUTTON** to release the liquid.
- If the needle guard is attached, press the BLACK button on the back of the needle guard to release the needle shield.

4. Set dose



- Turn the BLACK ring until the dose lines up with WHITE pointer.
- Be careful not to turn the **GREY** dial.

NOTE: If you cannot turn the **BLACK** ring, press the **INJECTION BUTTON** until it stops clicking and try again. 5. Dial up dose



- Turn the **GREY** dial in the direction of the arrows (clockwise) until it stops clicking.
- The dose on the **BLACK** rod should be the same as the dose in memory window.

6. Give injection



- Prepare the injection site.
- Push the pen down on injection site to insert needle into skin.
- Push the **INJECTION BUTTON** down until it stops clicking. Wait 5 seconds before you pull the needle out.
- Place the outer needle cover into the end of the needle shield
- Use the needle cover to push in the needle shield until it locks into place
- Use the needle cover to unscrew the needle and put it in a proper container for used needles
- Leave the needle guard on the pen
- Put the black cap on the needle guard. Store your pen in the refrigerator





2. Dial up the dose



Make sure the dose you have dialled up on the **BLACK** rod is the same as the dose you set in the memory window.

3. Give the injection



Remove the needle, replace the cap (black cap with needle-guard, white cap without) and store in the refrigerator.
