

Seagen Cookies Policy

This Cookies Policy informs you about the types of “cookies” and other technologies used by Seagen, Inc. and its subsidiaries (“we,” “our,” or “us”) and our third-party providers at the website or online service (collectively, the “Services”) where this Cookies Policy appears.

“Cookies” are identifiers that assist in the interaction between your computer or device and the Services. Different types of cookies, such as session and persistent cookies, are used for different purposes. Session cookies remain on your device temporarily until you leave the Services. A persistent cookie remains on your device for longer or until you manually delete it (how long the cookie remains on your device will depend on the duration of the specific cookie).

We and our third-party analytics and advertising providers generally use the following types of cookies and other technologies, such as GIF files or web beacons:

- **Strictly Necessary.** These cookies are essential to navigate the Services and use the features, and they enable us to provide the Services. Strictly Necessary cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be switched off. They relate to cookies that are set in response to specific requests you make on the website (setting your privacy preferences, logging in, or completing forms), as well as cookies that help our team verify the website is functioning as it should. If you set your browser to block or alert you about these types of cookies, some parts of the site may not work.
- **Functional.** These cookies are used to recognize you when you use the Services and enable our website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They are set by us or by third party providers whose services we add to our pages to enable enhanced functionality and personalization. Not allowing these cookies may impact how enhanced/personalized services function.
- **Performance and Analytics.** These cookies are used to understand and improve the Services and understand how you use the Services. They allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us understand user behavior on the website so we can improve visitor experience, in addition to helping us understand where visitors come from and the overall performance of our digital presence. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and anonymous to us. If you do not allow these cookies we will not be able to monitor the site’s performance.
- **Advertising/Targeting.** These cookies may be set through our site by our advertising partners. They are used by companies to build a profile of your interests, add you to a list of visitors to a page (or pages) on our site, and show you relevant advertisements on other sites. Targeting cookies do not store directly identifiable personal information but are based on uniquely identifying your browser and internet device. Not allowing these cookies will impact how ads are targeted to your online behavior. These are used to deliver and retarget relevant ads and track ad campaign performance and efficiency.

The specific cookies and technologies we use are subject to change, and not all of the technologies maybe used for all of the Services or in all jurisdictions.

Information collected through cookies and other technologies may include your IP address, geolocation information, device information, browsing activity, and search engine referrals. Some third-party cookies placed on our website may be considered a “sale or share” as used for our “targeted” or “cross-contextual” advertising

campaigns under California law. You can opt-out of these cookies by accessing our cookie preference center through the “Your Privacy Choices” link, which is available at the bottom of each website. When you access the Services, our advertising and analytics partners may collect precise geolocation information to provide targeted advertising and analytics services. You can manage the collection of location information using your device setting and controls.

Most web browsers allow you to set preferences about cookies you wish to accept. To control cookies on a device, consult your browser settings and follow the instructions. If you remove or block cookies, you may not be able to use or access certain features.

Third-party advertising partners may use cookies and similar technology to automatically collect certain information regarding use of the Services and other websites and may use the information to serve targeted ads for products and services that may be of interest based on your activity. We may limit interest-based advertising to users in certain jurisdictions as we deem necessary to comply with applicable laws. To learn more about interest-based advertising and how you can opt-out of having your web browsing information used for interest-based advertising by companies that participate in the Network Advertising Initiative (“NAI”) or Digital Advertising Alliance (“DAA”), visit the [NAI](#) (US) and [DAA](#) AdChoices (US) websites. Note, however, that not all advertising providers participate in the NAI and DAA. In addition, if you opt-out, you may still see online advertising from us and third parties, but the ads may be less relevant to you. If you delete or block cookies, buy or use a different device, access the Services from a different device, login under a different name, or change web browsers, you will need to opt-out again. If your web browser is configured to transmit “do not track” signals, we support such signals and will not load any third-party trackers.
